

## Disclaimer

### **The recipient (“User”) understands and agrees to the following:**

The information depicted in the Public Utilities Data Portal (“Portal”), including utility locations, pipe material, pipe size, and service lateral locations should be considered approximate. Field verification by the User is required for exact location, material, size, length, invert, and rim elevations. The information included in the Portal shall not be used by the User for preparation of construction plans or otherwise used for construction without field verification (survey) of the information. The user expressly waives any and all claims for damages (including economic or consequential), delays, or any losses whatsoever related to information contained in the Portal.

Recent and on-going construction activities are taking place in many areas of the depicted map. New and relocated utilities are often associated with new construction, including but not limited to system repairs. The Water Reclamation and Stormwater facilities (stormwater, sanitary sewer and reclaimed water) depicted on the Portal are primarily based on final as-built survey prepared by third parties for acceptance by the City. The User shall be aware that there is a time lag between pipe installation and the time of as-built survey acceptance by the City. Underground facilities that are not yet depicted in the City’s GIS database (i.e. not yet accepted by the City) are the responsibility of the Contractor who installed the underground facilities.

Recent and on-going construction activities are taking place in the vicinity of the I-4 Ultimate project. The City has not yet received final as-built survey of utility work associated with the I-4 Ultimate project. Underground facilities that are not yet depicted in the Portal (i.e. not yet accepted by the City) are the responsibility of the Contractor who installed the underground facilities. In this case, the I-4 Ultimate Utility Coordination team, and/or FDOT will need to be contacted regarding new and relocated facilities in this area.

The Water Reclamation Division does not mark in the field private sanitary sewer facilities, such as those depicted in this Portal. The owner of the private facility is responsible for marking their utility in the field. It is the responsibility of the Contractor working in the ROW to notify the owner of the private utility to mark their facilities in the ROW.

The User is advised to contact the Water Reclamation and Streets and Stormwater Division prior to use of the Portal for Due Diligence, Design, or Construction.

Chapter 556, Florida Statute, Sunshine One Call (811) applies to all work involving excavation in the State of Florida. It is the Contractor’s responsibility to comply with Chapter 556 F.S. and not rely solely on the Portal prior to executing excavations and other underground activities, such as directional bore/drilling.

Data is removed from the GOAA (airports) and Universal Studios areas of the Portal as they are not managed by the City of Orlando and their data is protected.
